
In this information sheet, you will learn about the Self-Serve Terminal (SST) equipment features, how to open equipment doors and access cash and coin boxes

#### **Self-Serve Terminal External View**

- 1. **Marketing Display** 
  - · Provides marketing and promotional information for Players
- 2. **Touch Screen Display** 
  - Guides Players to purchase and validate Lottery products
- **Payment Card Terminal** 3.
  - Players will have the option to pay with Debit / Credit Cards
- 4. **Ticket / Voucher Scanner** 
  - Validates Tickets or Vouchers
- **Ticket / Voucher Printer** 5.
  - Prints out Ticket purchase or Voucher
- 6. **Bill Acceptor** 
  - Accepts all Canadian banknotes
- 7. **Coin Acceptor** 
  - · Accepts Canadian coins
- Coin Return 8.
  - · Player's access point for returned coins
- 9. **Keys** 
  - 3 colour-coded keys to open the Self-Serve Terminal

#### **Keys to SST**

Each Retailer will receive 3 colour coded keys for each of the 4 locks on the SST.

KEY LOCATION & COLOURS	
Location on SST	Key Colour
Bottom Door	Blue
Printer Door	Green
Bill Acceptor Door	Red
Coin Acceptor Door	Red

 Gives access to Bill Acceptor and Coin Acceptor






### **Equipment Overview**

#### **Turning On/Off Self-Serve Terminal**

 Retailer will use the **Blue** key to open Bottom Door



- To turn the Self-Serve Terminal On or Off, use the button located on the back of the PC Unit
  - Hold down the button until the SST Touchscreen Display and Marketing Display turn off
  - Repeat steps to turn back on













Validated Tickets and Vouchers will not be kept inside the SST. Please ensure Players dispose of Tickets when they no longer require them.












#### **Ticket / Voucher Printer**

#### **How to Load Paper Roll**

- 1. Place roll on metal spindle.
- 2. Feed the paper edge between the two green panels until the printer detects it.
- The printer will automatically pull the paper and cut a section of it.
- 4. The printer is ready for use.





#### **Low Paper Warning**

When the paper roll is low it will trigger a **pop-up warning** on the SST and prevent the Player from creating a Ticket.



Retailer intervention required printer: Paper Low

When the Printer Door is open you may experience a Low Paper Warning even if you have a full Lotto Roll.

- This happens due to the weight of the Lotto Roll shifting when the Printer Door is open.
- Once the Printer Door is closed, the Low Paper Warning will disappear
- IF Error does not disappear, please perform a hard reboot




**Printer Cover Open Error** 

If the SST is showing a **Printer Cover Error**, please follow these tips:

1. Ensure the Printer Cover Door (front Green Tab) is closed by pushing it down




- 2. Find the Paper Feed button, located on the left side of the Printer.
- 3. Press the Paper Feed button to feed the Lotto Roll
- 4. The Paper Feed light will turn GREEN



### **Emptying the Cash Box**

 Retailer will use the RED key to open Bill Acceptor Door





Press the BLUE Latches located on both sides of the Cash Box. Pull the Cash Box out.



3. Rotate Lock **CLOCKWISE** until in the "OPEN" position and the Lock releases



4. Open the Cash Box and retrieve cash





Follow steps in reverse to return the Cash Box. Cash Box is placed correctly when a \*click noise\* is heard, and unit motors begin to operate.

### **Emptying the Coin Box**

 Retailer will use the **Blue** key to open Bottom Door



2. Use the **Red** key to unlock the Coin Box



3. Grab the Coin Box from its front handle and slide it out to collect coins





**PLEASE NOTE:** Make sure the Coin Box is closed and locked before closing the Bottom Door.
