### Questions & Answers

#### 1. Why is there a difference between my GTR and weekly Invoice amounts?

There are several factors that could contribute to a discrepancy between the **Net Amount for Lottery Terminals** on the Invoice and the **Net Amount** on the GTR. Please note the following:

- **Back-Office Sales:** If a S&W Activation Ticket was activated in the back-office by BCLC, the sale will be included in the Sales-S&W in the weekly Invoice but not the GTR.
- **Traditional Ticket Orders:** The General Terminal Report (GTR) shows Traditional Ticket orders received during the report period. On the Invoice, payment for Traditional Ticket orders appear **28 days after the order has been received**. To match a Traditional Ticket order with your Invoice, use a GTR dated 28 days before the invoice date.

#### 2. Why is there be a difference between Validations – FT S&W and Sales – FT S&W, when these are typically the same?

Good question! This difference happens when a player validates a Scratch & Win (S&W) ticket that wins a Free Play On Demand ticket.

##### For Example:

- The **\$5 Keno Cashout S&W ticket** features a **\$5 Keno On Demand Free Play Ticket prize**. Since you are validating a Scratch & Win Ticket the **validation** will be included in the **Val – FT S&W** section of the GTR. However, because the Free Play is issued as a **Keno On Demand** ticket, the **sale** will be included in the **Sales – FT On Demand** section of the GTR. Please **see pages 3 and 4** where this example is highlighted using blue text.
- **Note:** The **Val – FT S&W Commissions** and the **Sales - FT On Demand Commissions** earned for the validation and sale of a **\$5 Keno Cashout Free Play prize** will also follow the same logic. Please **see pages 7 and 8** where this example is highlighted using blue text.

### Questions & Answers

#### 3. When is an Activation Ticket sale recorded?

An Activation Ticket sale is recorded when the ticket is scanned through the Lottery Terminal, and the Checkout process is completed.

- **Activation Options:** Tickets can be activated as a full pack or one at a time.
- **Why It Matters:** If a ticket isn't activated, Players will not be able to check or validate their ticket, causing a negative Player experience.

#### 4. I have 2 Lottery Terminals at my store. Do I need to pull a GTR from each one to balance with my Invoice?

Yes, you do. To match your Lottery Invoice correctly, you must pull a GTR from each Lottery Terminal. Here's how to read the reports:

- **Per Terminal section:** Shows transactions for each terminal separately. You'll need to add these together to get the full store total.
- **Per Store section:** Shows the combined total for your entire store. You do not need to add anything here—this section already includes both terminals.

#### 5. My store sells WebCash. Where can I find the Sales and Commissions?

##### On the GTR:

- WebCash Sales are listed under **Sales – S&W**
- WebCash Commissions are listed under **Sales - S&W – Commissions**

##### On the Invoice:

- WebCash Sales are included in **S&W Activation Sales**
- WebCash Commissions are included in the **Sales Commissions**

#### 6. Will my Sweep Day and Invoice timing change?

No, Sweep Day and Invoice timing will remain the same.
