What is it?

Retail support – April 2 to June 30. Retail POS support will include a display case strip and bubble case banner (where applicable).



Questions & Answers

Can residents outside of BC enter the contest? Can someone under 19 years of age enter the contest?

No. Technically this is a National ticket offering and contest with multiple provinces participating. However, for tickets purchased in BC, players must first select the Province of BC on the contest site and register an account with a BC address. Online contest codes from tickets purchased in BC will only work on the BC contest page. If a BC resident purchases a Jackpot ticket from another province, they will not be able to enter those online contest codes on the BC contest page. Players must be 19 years or older to enter the contest.

Are Lottery Retailers eligible for this contest?

As per the Contest Rules, Lottery Retailers and household members are <u>not</u> eligible entrants in this contest. Household member means a spouse (including common-law), child, or parent, whether residing with the Retailer or not, or anyone who resides with the Retailer.

Can players use their existing Tech the Halls accounts or accounts they have created for other Scratch & Win 2nd Chance Contests?

No. This is a separate contest with multiple lottery participation and therefore a new account must be created.

Which tickets are eligible?

Winning and non-winning tickets that are part of the Jackpot Family of tickets are eligible for the 2nd Chance Contest:

- \$5 \$100,000 Jackpot (GAME ID: 104004)
- \$10 \$500,000 Jackpot (GAME ID: 104005)
- \$20 \$1,000,000 Jackpot (GAME ID: 104006)

Where can players find the online contest code on a ticket?

The 11-digit online contest code can be found at the bottom left of the ticket, under the latex covering.

Questions & Answers

Can players enter multiple tickets at once?

Yes. Players can enter multiple tickets at once to a maximum of 51 unique contest codes per day. In addition, players that purchase all 3 price points in the Jackpot Family of tickets (\$5, \$10 and \$20) and enter all 3 contest codes at the same time will receive 25 bonus entries.

How many contest entries do players get for each ticket?

1 entry for each \$1 spent:

- \$5 \$100,000 Jackpot = 5 contest entries
- \$10 \$500,000 Jackpot = 10 contest entries
- \$20 \$1,000,000 Jackpot = 20 contest entries

In addition to entries from each ticket purchase, players will play a Slots Bonus Game on the contest site to win additional Bonus entries.

Do players have to make purchases in order to enter the contest?

No. Players can request a no-purchase-necessary contest code. Details on how to make a request can be found in the FAQ section on the contest site.

What happens to entries that do not win the weekly draw?

The eligible entry period for weekly draws starts on a Monday and ends the following Sunday. All entries received during this period will be submitted for that week's draw. All non-winning entries will be carried over to the Grand Prize draw for \$250,000.

Will players know how many entries they have?

Yes. Players can review their Entry History on the contest site.

What are the odds of winning a prize?

The odds of winning are based on the number of entries received.

Questions & Answers

How will players be notified if they win?

For prize draws, winners will be contacted at the phone number and/or email address and/or mailing address provided with their registration information within 10 days of the applicable draw.

How will the public be informed of the winners?

A list of the winners will be displayed on JACKPOTFAMILY.CA after the winners have been confirmed, approximately 6 to 8 weeks after each draw date.

How will players receive their prizes?

A cheque will be mailed out once the winner has been confirmed.

What if a player does not have a computer? Can they still enter the contest?

We understand that not all players have access to the Internet from their home. These players may wish to visit their public library or local Internet Café where web browsing is available. A unique email address is required to enter the contest. There is no way to enter The Jackpot Family 2nd Chance Contest offline.
